I. Availability in Clusters

III. How to Access the H&SS Server Using a Windows Machine

The following are the steps I followed to access the H&SS server HSSHELIOS using a Windows NT machine. I presume to do this using Windows 95 is very similar.

Select **Network Neighborhood**→**Entire Network**→**Microsoft Windows Network**→**HSSComputing**→**HSSHELIOS**

You then need to use your COURSE ID: 36201 and your course PASSWORD: 36201 to get access to the folder called *Class* and then to the course datafiles.
